RATIONALE:

Mobile phones/smart watches are now a feature of modern society and most of our pupils own one. Increasing sophistication of mobile phone/smart watch technology presents a number of issues for schools:

- The high value of many mobile phones/smart watches.
- The integration of cameras into mobile phones/smart watches leading to potential child protection and data protection issues.
- The potential to use the mobile phone/smart watch e.g. for video, texting whilst on silent mode.
- Access to internet sites that may be inappropriate.

It is not realistic to prohibit mobile phones/smart watches being brought to school, nor is it logistically possible for schools to collect mobile phones/smart watches in each morning and return them in the afternoon. It is our policy to allow pupils to have a mobile phone/smart watch with them in school under the conditions outlined below.

POLICY:

- Mobile phones/smart watches must not be used for any purpose (e.g. phoning, texting, surfing the internet, taking photos, checking the time, taking videos) whilst at school.
- 2. Mobile phones must always be switched off (not on silent mode) and kept out of view.
- 3. If a pupil breaches these rules the mobile phone/smart watch will be confiscated and given in to the Head of Year and parents will be contacted and asked to collect the mobile phone/smart watch.
- 4. Mobile phones/smart watches must not be taken into examinations.

This policy should be read in conjunction with the school's other policies in particular the Positive Behaviour Policy / Anti Bullying Policy / Acceptable Use of the ICT Network Policy.

EMERGENCIES:

If a pupil needs to contact his/her parents/guardians, they will be allowed to use a school telephone.

If parents need to contact children urgently they should telephone the school office and a message will be relayed promptly.





MOBILE PHONE AGREEMENT
